Dry Cleaning

Dry-cleaning uses fluids to remove soils and stains from fabrics. Among the advantages of dry-cleaning is its ability to dissolve grease and oils in a way that water cannot. Natural fibres such as wools and silks dry-clean beautifully, but can shrink, distort, and lose colour when washed in water.

Synthetic fibres like polyester also respond well to dry-cleaning, whereas they can retain oily stains after washing. Dry-cleaning helps to return garments to a "like-new" condition using precautions to prevent shrinkage, loss of colour, and change of texture or finish.
